Using reclaimed wood, tile, metal, glass, and more from the Store, Builders will have one month to craft pieces of functional art for the home... a kitchen island or a hanging lamp or even a complete dining set!

Removing barriers to reuse & repair takes more than keeping our reclaimed materials & home repair classes affordable.

This year, our new Home Repair for All program will extend free access to materials, classes, home delivery, & open shop time for over 75 low-income homeowners.

# HOW DOES IT WORK?



## THE MAIN EVENT

They will have one month to fashion a unique creation of functional art for the Living Room, Dining Room, Kitchen, or Garden.

For three weeks before the Main Event, the Builds will be on display in the ReBuilding Center Pop-Up Gallery. Customers & supporters may purchase raffle tickets for a chance to win one of the finished pieces. The Builder with the most raffle tickets wins The Scrappy!

# ABOUT REBUILDING CENTER



## Reuse is the foundation of everything we do.

Since 1997, we have moved countless tons of useful building materials and home goods out of the waste stream and into the hands of the people who need them.

Our 30,000 sq. foot store is a treasure trove of Portland architectural history, salvaged from deconstructed and renovated old homes.

But barriers to reuse remain for those who lack time or resources.

We want to remove those barriers, keeping higher quality, reclaimed materials affordable and easing access for everyone.

## Repair = Empowerment

Being able to repair a busted pipe before catastrophic failure means not having to choose between paying a plumber or the mortgage.

Through our education classes, we teach our community how to perform safe, affordable, sustainable home repairs and improvements.

We empower our community, saving them money, helping them retain their homes, and building up economic resilience, all while keeping usable materials out of the landfill.



# REBUILDING FOR JUSTICE

At ReBuilding Center, we build on our strengths to interrupt the environmental, racial, and economic injustice that continue to fuel our climate crisis.

## WHAT CAN WE DO?

We can strengthen community resilience by focusing on the needs of people most at risk of losing their homes and most vulnerable to the ravages of environmental disaster.

One way we are doing this is through our new Home Repair for All program. Low-income homeowners learn to care for their homes together, receiving free access to our calendar of classes, our shop space, our materials, and our delivery services.
